# **Uniform Policy**

# **Purpose**

The Department of Education supports the wearing of school uniform, and outlines the purpose as follows:

- promoting a sense of belonging for students
- creating a positive identity for the school community
- ensuring personal safety of students by allowing easier recognition of students inside the school and in the community
- promoting health and safety by identifying items necessary for particular activities

# Overview

Our school uniform is the result of formal consultation with students, teachers and other staff, parents and carers, and the school community (including the Parents and Citizens' Association).

The expectation at Hoxton Park Public School is that all students wear the school uniform during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when engaging in school activities outside of school hours.

The exception to wearing school uniform includes mufti and special days. These special 'out of uniform' days are identified and outlined for parents by a note sent home with their child/ren.

# Responsibilities

#### Principal is to:

- lead consultation during a review of school uniform
- oversee school uniform suppliers
- inform parents and carers of school uniform requirements
- provide assistance to families as required

#### Teachers are to:

encourage students to wear full school uniform

#### Parents are to:

- provide their child/children with a school uniform that meets the school's uniform requirements
- provide the school with a note explaining why their child/ children are out of school uniform

#### Students are to:

• wear a school uniform that meets the school's uniform requirements

# Out of Uniform Process

Step 1: If a student is out of uniform they are provided with an out of uniform slip to take home to their parent/carer.

Step 2: Parents/Carers are to sign the out of uniform slip.

Step 3: Students return the slip to their classroom teacher.

If the slip is not returned, classroom teachers will call the parent/carer to ensure their child/children gave the note to their parent/carer.

Step 4: If the uniform issue continues, the stage supervisor will make contact with parents/carers to ensure the parent/carer is aware of the school uniform policy and how the school could help support their child/ren to wear full school uniform.

#### Boys

#### Safety

For safety purposes, some uniform expectations are nonnegotiable.

Black leather shoes and an apron must be worn by all students participating in cooking experiences.

All students must wear a school hat to participate in break times, sport and learning experiences that take place in unshaded areas of the school and offsite.

### Accessories

When participating in cooking, sport, fitness activities and science experiments, the wearing of accessories and false nails can be a safety issue. Outlined below are the guidelines for accessories. Jewellery:

- Earrings may include studs or small sleepers.
- A single ring may be worn.
- One necklace may be worn underneath clothing (excluding costume jewellery).
- No bracelets are to be worn.
- Watches are acceptable (excluding SMART watches with communication capabilities).

Nails

- No fake or acrylic nails, and only clear nail polish may be worn.
- \* All hair accessories must be maroon or black.
